Discussion

 Re- introduce the idea of communication in relation to the objects in bottles made last term

Show Postcard

Postcards made from the groups work are handed back to the students

Who am I? - brainstorming session

- Workshop leader stands at the front of the group and thinks of a well known person (eg Einstein, Napoleon, Madonna)
- Each member of the group has to ask one question (the answer to which can only be yes or no) with which to guess the identity of the personality

Questions on Postcards

• Each student must think of one question to find out more about Stephen Turner and then write it onto their postcard.

Making props

 Using the construction materials provided, every student will make a microphone with logo badge (see pic)



 For those students who finish quickly they will also be asked to make a simple name badge using card and a safety pin.

Filming Interview

- The group will pose together with their props and filmed in a mock studio shot clamouring for Stephen Turner's attention
- Working in three smaller groups (the workshop leader groups) each student will take it in turns to ask their questions to camera (reading them from the postcard) using their props.
- A video can them be edited cutting together the group shots and close up questions. This will be shown to Stephen in week 4.

Interview video

 Using the questions recorded in week 17 Stephen will be filmed answering the questions as he watches the video. (the shot should include Stephen and the students microphones at the bottom of the shot as if they were asking questions live)

MAKE £1 OBJECT FLOAT

£1 objects

- Think of an object under a pound that could be bought for Stephen to use whilst on the fort.
- These objects will then be bought by the workshop leaders for use in the following weeks activities.
- Each student will be given the £1 object they selected in the previous session.
- Using the construction materials provided build a housing for your object so that it floats in a sink of water.
- Try to think how you might decorate your floating object so that it resembles a transportation device that might be used at sea.
- Photocopies of water based vehicles will be provided for reference.

Responses


Look at all the responses to our postcards from Stephen Turner.

Brainstorming

T-shirts

- Using stencils and fabric pens write out instruction on t-shirt. Instruction should be upside down so that Stephen can read it while wearing T-shirt.
- Use fabric paints to colour in letters
- · Use pens and paint to design a logo onto the t-shirt
